

What is a solo skiff?

The Solo Skiff is well-built with a solid construction. One of its great features is the split tail and forward transom, which puts the small outboard right at your fingertips. This design allows you to steer the boat from a central position without the need for a tiller extension.

What are the reasons to buy a solo skiff?

The Solo Skiff has several attractive features. One reason to buy it is the roto molded plastic construction, which eliminates the fear of damaging the boat near oyster beds or the shoreline. Another great feature is the split tail and forward transom. The boat is also built with solid construction that must be seen and touched to fully appreciate.

How do you land a fish in a Solo Skiff?

Landing a fish in a Solo Skiff is simple. You can usually grab the leader and slide the fish over the gunnel. Using a Lip Grip or a net is also easy because you can move around in the Solo Skiff. If you're keeping the fish, the built-in cooler is right there and easy to open.

Can a Solo Skiff be swamped?

The Solo Skiff cannot be swamped. When taking boat wakes and waves over the bow, the water just disappears off the stern in a matter of seconds. Swamping a Solo Skiff is not an issue.

Is a Solo Skiff better than a kayak?

When it comes to cruising for fish, a Solo Skiff can be used just like a kayak. However, it is far better than a kayak because you can easily access your gear and cooler without any effort. You can also turn around and fish off the back.
