

How do you get solar sailer?

The Solar Sailer stops at the Central Computer Mesa. All four new chests are located here; open them all for an Orichalcum+, an AP Boost, the Central Computer Core Map, and the Cosmic Arts accessory (Treasures #11-14). Use the only other pathway to reach a pair of boss fights. You will need to have Tron in the party. This guy is a total pushover.

What happens to Sora and Riku when the portal closes?

When the Portal closes, Sora and Riku are converted into data and change forms accordingly. The forms resemble the outfits worn by other characters in the film.

Does Sora get a photon debugger?

Sora receives the Photon Debugger Keyblade from Tron before leaving. The Album gets the regular four entries, and the Characters section is completed. The first episode of Space Paranoids is complete, but Episode 2 in Hollow Bastion isn't over quite yet. Return to the KH2: Hollow Bastion page to continue the game.

How does Sora get into light cycle?

Thanks to Goofy, Sora is immediately thrust into a game of Light Cycle. The first phase simply requires Sora to defeat a few Heartless, and works as a training mission. The second phase is much longer. The route through the maze appears random, but it always ends at the exit, so don't worry about taking the correct path through it.

What happened to Sora in Disk Wars?

In Kingdom Hearts: Birth by Sleep - A Fragmentary Passage, Sora is blown out the doors by the wind and finds himself in the Disk Wars stadium. Here, he encounters CLU and Rinzler, and a fight ensues.

Who tells Sora he can get through to Rinzler?

CLU offers to release Rinzler in exchange for the Keyblade, but Sora refuses. Rinzler attacks Sora, who fights back when Quorra tells him he can get through to Rinzler. Sora defeats Rinzler and reprograms him back to Tron, but CLU appears and attempts to take out Sora with his Disk.
