

Tesla charging stations open to non tesla cars

Will tesla open a supercharger network to non-Tesla electric cars?

Tesla announced that it is starting to open its Supercharger network to non-Tesla electric cars in China. It's another step toward making the Supercharger network a fully-opened global charging network. The automaker first started to open Supercharger stations to non-Tesla electric vehicles in Europe in 2021.

Will a Tesla Supercharger charge a non-Tesla EV?

Tesla is finally opening up its Supercharger network to non-Tesla vehicles. It's now possible to charge a non-Tesla EV at a Tesla Supercharger.

First,download the Tesla app for your iOS or Android device and set up an account. You'll see a list of Tesla chargers near you,including what speed they use and whether they're open to the public.The first thing you'll probably see on the homescreen is "Charge Your Non-Tesla."

It may be useful to know that the Tesla charging network also has Destination chargers for slower charging (up to 22 kW) over a number of hours. These have Type 2 connectors so can be used by a wide range of non-Tesla electric carssuch as the Vauxhall Corsa and MG4.

Does Tesla have a Supercharger station?

This now gives owners of EVs made by Volvo,Mercedes,Ford,BMW,and scores of others access to many Supercharger stations,making long-distance travel easier than ever. Tesla has about 40,000 Superchargers worldwide and about 17,000 are in the US.

For an EV with a 60kWh battery, you'll pay roughly \$35 to \$42 to fully charge a Tesla car or \$47.40 for a non-Tesla car, which comes down to \$39.60 for a non-Tesla with the monthly subscription.

By the end of 2025, nearly all EVs will have access to some of Tesla's Supercharger fast EV charging stations. Already, some Ford Mustang Mach-E, F-150 Lightning, Rivian R1S and R1T owners have ...
