

What happened to Titan solar power?

US residential installer Titan Solar Power ceased operations late last week, with an alleged email to employees suggesting "negotiations fell through" with a would-be buyer of the company. Founded in 2013 in Arizona, the company was present in 16 states and, for the past six months, was negotiating with a potential buyer to acquire the company.

Is Titan solar closing its doors?

Titan Solar, which installed thousands of systems across the U.S., informed its employees June 13 that it was "closing its doors," having failed to secure a buyer for the company, according to an email obtained by TIME. In the email, Titan said that it had helped over 100,000 households go solar.

How much money does Titan solar power have in bankruptcy?

Titan Solar Power, which was founded locally in 2013, filed for Chapter 7 bankruptcy protection June 20. The company estimated it has between \$1 million and \$10 million in assets against \$1 million and \$10 million in liabilities, according to its petition with the U.S. Bankruptcy Court for the District of Arizona.

Was a new buyer sent to Titan solar power employees?

This new buyer was meant to bring "new sales channels to the company and take us in a new direction" according to an email shared on social platform Reddit that is alleged to have been sent to employees of Titan Solar Power (see below). PV Tech has been running an annual PV CellTech Conference since 2016.

Is Titan solar a good solar contractor?

Consistently ranked as a Top Solar Contractor based on volume, Titan began its solar construction business in 2013 in Arizona and installed solar in over 20 states. The shared email states that Titan Solar was negotiating with a potential buyer to acquire the installation company, but the deal fell through. The company closed on Thursday.

How does Titan solar work?

Titan Solar worked through a dealership program, wherein Titan would partner with third-party sales contractors while managing installation in-house. The residential solar market is experiencing some turbulence this year. Residential contractors have been hit with high interest rates on loans and pushback from utilities and states.
