Can veterans get a loan for solar panels?

The Department of Veterans Affairs (VA) offers the Energy Efficient Mortgages program for loans to veterans of up to \$6,000 for solar panels. Solar panels convert the energy of sunlight into electricity,a process known as photovoltaics.

Can disabled veterans get solar panels?

Yes,disabled veterans can get solar panels for their homesthrough the federal government's High Energy Cost Grant Program. Managed by the U.S. Department of Agriculture,this program offers grants in areas with high energy costs.
