

Where can I charge my electric car in Washington State?

In Washington State, the city of Seattle has 1650 public charging station ports within 15km. 93% of these ports are Level 2 charging ports, and 47% offer free charges for your electric car. Seattle, also known as Emerald City, is a port city with a dynamic downtown full of activities.

Where can I charge my EV in Washington?

Washington's segment of the West Coast Electric Highway connects drivers to similar fast charging networks in British Columbia and Oregon. Description: Charging is FREE to EV drivers at this rest area. Electricity is provided by Adopt-A-Charger and the Seattle Electric Vehicle Association.
