

Who owns West Penn Power?

SOURCE FirstEnergy Corp. West Penn Power, a subsidiary of FirstEnergy Corp. (NYSE: FE), has begun work to connect a pair of solar energy projects in Fulton and Franklin counties to the electric grid.

What services does West Penn Energy provide?

When will West Penn Power & FirstEnergy connect?

West Penn Power expects to complete the connection work for both projects in late 2023, with the two solar farms expected to be in service and delivering clean energy in early 2024. FirstEnergy continues to make investments that support clean energy and improve grid reliability and resiliency.

Will West Penn Power expand its McConnellsburg substation?

For the first project, West Penn Power will expand its McConnellsburg substation in Fulton County and add a new terminal at the substation to provide a connection point for a 70-megawatt solar farm that AES is developing in Ayr Township. The second project is a 150-megawatt solar farm in Peters and Saint Thomas Townships in Franklin County.

Does West Penn Power supply electricity?

By default, West Penn Power customers receive both their electricity distribution and supply from the utility. This means that West Penn Power does supply electricity to its customers. You still get your bill through West Penn Power, so the only change for you is your electricity rate.

Who is West Penn Power?

West Penn Power is a utility company that serves 720,000 residential and business customers across Pennsylvania. It is part of the FirstEnergy group of companies and has roots dating back to 1916. West Penn Power's service area spans 24 counties around the Keystone State, including parts of Pittsburgh.
