

# What cars can you charge at a tesla charging station

Does Tesla charge at a Supercharger station?

Tesla owners are billed for charging by the minute or kilowatt-hour for "supercharging" subject to local law. While Tesla drivers have the company's Level 3 and newer Supercharger stations exclusively right now, they can charge at most any EV charging station that utilizes adaptor cables.

Can my electric car now use a Tesla Supercharger?

Can your electric car now use a Tesla Supercharger? After announcing its intention to open the Supercharger network to non-Tesla EVs toward the end of 2024, Tesla now have a number of locations dotted around the UK where those with any old EV with a CCS charger can use their Supercharger Network.

Can a Tesla EV charge a car with a CCS port?

Existing EVs with the CCS-type port will be compatible with Tesla's supercharger network through an adapter.

Why does Ford only charge at Tesla stations?

Ford found that its drivers power up at Tesla stations only 20% of the time. Adapter availability, wait times, or charge port placement issues could be to blame. The cables that run from the Supercharger to the car are too short to reach the port on some non-Tesla vehicles, such as Fords.

How can BMW EV owners pay for charging at Tesla superchargers?

BMW says its working on integrating a way to pay for charging with an in-car app as well as providing directions to Tesla chargers through the car's navigation. Existing EVs with the CCS-type port will also be compatible with Tesla's supercharger network through an adapter.

Does Tesla have a supercharger network?

Here's how we got here. In a major win for EV drivers, Tesla is opening up its Supercharger network to all non-Tesla EVs. So far, ten brands can power up at select stations: Ford, Rivian, General Motors (GM), Polestar, Volvo, Nissan, Lucid, Mercedes-Benz, and--as of this week--Hyundai and Genesis.

This means that you can use a Tesla charger for other cars. Tesla also uses Type 2 connectors for its standard, non-Supercharger setups. ... These chargers allow you to charge a Tesla or other compatible car rapidly, being able to boost EVs ...

**Q:** Can cars with CHAdeMO charging ports use Tesla Superchargers? No. While there are adapters that allow NACS-equipped cars to use CHAdeMO chargers, the reverse option isn't available.

Only electric cars fitted with a CCS-type plug can use a Tesla Supercharger, while Destination chargers use a standard Type 2 connector, which should be compatible with most electric cars....

“Adapters will be made available for purchase through our GM vehicle brand apps in early 2024, where customers can also find, charge, and pay for sessions at charging stations with NACS connectors.”
