

Which Wilson irons have power holes?

The Dynapower Forgedplayer's distance irons, released last January, are the last Wilson irons to feature Power Holes. Those are due for replacement next year. The 2025 Wilson Dynapower family is, without question, the biggest single-year launch in Wilson's 111-year history.

What is the Wilson Dynapower iron?

The Wilson Dynapower iron is a muscle back iron that was originally launched in 1956. The new Dynapower iron is a testament to how technology has evolved since then.
